## RESOLUTION NO. 2018-140 LOWER BRULE SIOUX TRIBE

## APPROVE RESOLUTION ADOPTING RECOMMENDATION OF ELECTION BOARD CONCERNING TESTING OF CANDIDATES FOR DRUGS

WHEREAS, the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, as empowered by the Constitution and Bylaws, Article VI, Section 1, (e) the Tribal Council as authorized by law to safeguard and promote the peace, safety, morals, and general welfare of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe and to regulate and conduct of trade and the use and disposition of property upon the reservation provided that any ordinance directly affecting nonmembers of the reservation shall be subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior; and

**WHEREAS,** the Election Board unanimously passed a recommendation to the Lower Brule Sioux Tribal Council to adopt a Resolution permitting the random testing of bodily fluids for drugs at any time during the election of any candidates for office or anyone submitting a petition for an elected office; and

WHEREAS, the Election board as a part of that recommendation also unanimously passed that such testing may be conducted on more than one occasion or occurrence during an election for any candidate or person submitting a petition for office; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE RESOLVED**, that the Lower Brule Sioux Tribal Council does hereby formally adopts the recommendation of the Election Board permitting the random testing of bodily fluids for drugs at any time during the election of any candidates for office or anyone submitting a petition for an elected office; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Lower Brule Sioux Tribal Council does hereby formally adopts the recommendation of the Election Board permitting any such testing may be conducted on more than one occasion or occurrence during an election for any candidate or person submitting a petition or office.

## <u>CERTIFICATION</u>
